Sub: Invitation of application for **Short-term Research Grants for Undergraduate students 2023-24**

The applications are invited from the undergraduate students studying in colleges affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences for short-term research grants for the year 2023-24.

1. The calendar of events:

a	Hosting of the Application on RGUHS Website	10 th JAN 2023
b.	Uploading of selected five applications by the Head of the institution/College	Last date 28 th Feb 2023 (till evening 5:30 PM)
c.	Scrutiny of applications	First week March – 2023
d.	Evaluation of the Research proposals	Second week of March 2023
e.	Placing Selected research proposals before Finance committee /Syndicate meeting	April– 2023
f.	Communicating to selected Candidates	MAY – 2023
g.	Release of Research Grants	JUNE – 2023

2. Eligibility Criteria:

- (1) Students who have passed 1st year of examination and studying in 2nd Year onwards before entering final year may apply for this research grant.
- (2) The student shall carryout the research under the guidance of any teaching faculty having teaching experience of atleast five years after obtaining their post-graduate degree.
- (3) The project should be capable of being completed in three months.
- (4) The maximum amount that can be released for this grant is Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand only) per project.
- (5) Research Grants will be released into the Research Account in the name of Head of the Institution only.

3. Guidelines for Applying for short-term research grant

1.	The Application for the short-term research grant will be hosted on RGUHS Website (www.rguhs.ac.in/AdvancedResearch.html) as per the schedule mentioned above
2.	The eligible students shall download the application and duly filled applications shall be submitted to the head of the institution.
3.	Head of the institution shall constitute a committee and review and short list the best 05 proposals submitted by the students.
4.	Head of the institution shall upload the short-listed five proposals only to the University through online in the below mentioned link (www.rguhs.ac.in/AdvancedResearch.htm). In case more than 5 proposals are uploaded, then only the first five applications will be considered.
5.	The signed applications should be scanned and uploaded in PDF format in the above link by the Head of the Institution.
6.	The softcopy sent separately by email will not be considered. It has to be uploaded in the link mentioned above.
7.	Principal/student/guide should give their clear email ID and mobile.no for further contact.
8.	The Head of the Institute shall maintain a separate Research account into which the grant shall be credited.
8	Grants shall NOT be utilised for the purchase /rental/lease of the equipments (software/hardware) such as laptop, printers, notepads, mobile, voice recorders, books, furniture, pen drive, printers, internet charges, cartages, journals etc. Equipments/instruments, however small or big should not be purchased from the research grant.
09	The Refreshments for Patients/ students/data collection persons / drivers etc. are NOT admissible from the research grant.
10	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• All the bills should be GST bills and bills should have the company's /store's Reg. number, PAN number, and GST number.• Under circumstances where GST bills are not available, Producing copy of the GST exemption certificate is mandatory.
11	Paper presentation and publication is desirable but not mandatory.
12	Final project report should not exceed 100 pages including the cover pages.
13	Queries from audit section should be cleared immediately by the PI/Guide/Head of the institution.

4. Selection Procedure:



- (1) The Head of the Institution shall scrutinize and short-list research proposals at college level and approve a maximum of five research proposal per institute and only such proposals cleared by the Head of the Institution shall be submitted to the University.
- (2) After scrutiny by the Department of Advanced Research, the applications will be sent for Internal Evaluation following the below mentioned criteria.

Criteria for evaluation	Marks
Academic credentials (Marks obtained in previous examinations)	05
Novelty of the research proposal	05
Ability of the proposal to be taken forward in future	05
Robustness of the Research Methodology	10
TOTAL	25

Such of the students who after evaluation scores more than **17 marks** out of 25 marks, will be considered for release of Research Grants.

The students should apply the research grants in prescribed format given by RGUHS only. If any other formats are uploaded it will be rejected.

All the above instructions should be strictly adhered to with regard to filling and submission of application online, the failure of which will result in rejection of application.
