The Registrar extended a warm welcome to all the members for the 191st Special Syndicate and requested the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor to chair the meeting and conduct the proceedings. The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor also extended warm welcome to all the members of the Syndicate and the agenda of the meeting was taken up for discussion.

SUBJECT 191/ I: MANPOWER OUTSOURCE EMPLOYEE SALARY.

The Registrar explained the repeated requests of the outsourced employees, and also mentioned that, in the previous syndicate meeting the same subject was discussed in brief. In view of this, the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor has constituted a Sub-Committee, vide ref No. RGUHSB/PROC/MISC/4/2024, Dated 21/10/2024 with a Syndicate Member as the Chairperson, a Senate Member, Finance Officer, Legal Officer etc.

This committee has submitted its report. Along with this report, the Syndicate was briefed about the different options which were looked into by the committee and the annual financial burden in each of the options. The committee in its report has given two options.

The Syndicate noted that, the first option in the committee report was to give 25% of the existing wages to each of the personnel and the second option was to give 100 rupees less than the basic pay prescribed in the 7th pay scale in each of the equivalent cadre to all the employees.

The Registrar explained that, the wages given should not be equivalent to the basic pay of the permanent employees of the University in the respective cadres.

The matter of skilled and unskilled category among these outsourced employees was also discussed, especially the drivers, who will be frequently working late hours.

During the deliberations, it was also discussed about the non-availability of Junior Programmers, Programmers and Technical Experts because of low pay being paid in the University. Those who have joined have also left whenever they got better offer from other companies, which is hampering the development of IT related activities in the University.

The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor also expressed about the increase in the consolidated salary given to the Directors/Consultants appointed on contract basis for certain sections of the University.

After the thorough deliberations by the Syndicate, it was decided as follows:-

- 1. Regarding revision of the wages of the Outsourced employees: 22% of the existing wages** shall be increased to each of the outsourced employees.
- 2. Regarding revision of the wages of drivers:** As per the decision in the Sl. No. 1, the wages revision shall also be effective to the drivers. Along with this, the syndicate, authorized the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, to take decision regarding revision of the over time charges of the drivers and implement the same.


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3. **Regarding yearly increase in the consolidated pay of the junior and senior programmers:** Syndicate, authorized the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, to take decision regarding this in commensurate with the wages as per the industry standards in consultation with the Senior Technical Director of the NIC.
4. **Regarding revision of consolidated pay extended to the Directors / Consultants of the rank of retired Professors appointed on contract basis:** The Syndicate authorised the Vice Chancellor to fix the consolidated salary between Rs 1,50,000/- and Rs 2,00,000/- per month.
5. **Regarding revision of pay for other contractual employees:** The Vice-Chancellor was authorised to revise the pay accordingly.

SUBJECT 191/ II: APPEAL HEARING OF SRI JAIMADEGOWDA:

The Hon'ble Vice Chancellor left the Syndicate meeting by authorizing the Registrar Evaluation to preside over the meeting as his presence will be prejudice to the decision taken by the Appellate Authority.

The Registrar (Member Secretary), presented the case of Sri. Jaimadegowda in brief to the Appellate Authority.

In pursuance of the notice served upon Sri Jaimadegowda presented in person before the Appellate Authority. He submitted his oral arguments. In addition, he also filed a memo stating that his representation before this Appellate Authority shall be considered as his written argument.

Matter was discussed in length. The final decision of the Appellate Authority shall be intimated to the appellant in due course.


There is no PB B Sc Nursing Course.





SUBJECT 191/III (1): IMPLEMENTATION OF PGMER-2023 FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2021-22 BATCH OF STUDENTS REGARDING.

The following important aspects were discussed in detail by the CAC and the same were recommended.


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1. Attendance: In general ordinance governing Post Graduate Medical Education, it was decided as follows:-

Each year shall be taken as a unit for the purpose of calculating attendance. Every candidate is required to attend a minimum of 80% of the training during each academic year of the post graduate course. Provided further, leave of any kind shall not be counted as part of academic term without prejudice to minimum 80% attendance of training period every year.

This is discussed as below:

Regarding the attendance, the Dean of the Medical faculty expressed the following concerns


- i. As per the FAQ, if students attend 751 days out of 939 days, the student is eligible to attend the examinations. This means the student can be absent for 188 days i.e 6 months of the training period, the student can remain absent and still be able to appear for the examinations. This will lead to incomplete training period of post graduate student.
- ii. As per the communication of the authorities of the university in the CAC, the NMC has given oral communication that, PGMER-23 is to be followed for the batch of 2021-22. Hence, Dean is of the opinion that, for the batch of 2021-22 academic year students and also for the students who are taking up the examinations, these regulations may be followed, but university has to pursue with the NMC, regarding application of PGMER-23 from the academic year 2023-24 onwards.

2. Eligibility to appear for the University Examination

- i. Attendance: as specified above
- ii. Publications / Presentations / Poster presentation: as specified in the PGMER – 2023 it shall be applicable from the academic year 2021-22 batch onwards and for all the students who appear for the ensuing examination.
- iii. DRP – as per PGMER -2023, it shall be applicable from the academic year 2021-22 batch onwards and for all the students who appear for the ensuing examination.
- iv. BCBR - it shall be applicable from the academic year 2021-22 batch onwards and for all the students who appear for the ensuing examination.
- v. Ethics course - it shall be applicable from the academic year 2023 – 24 batch onwards.
- vi. BCLS & ACLS - it shall be applicable from the academic year 2022-23 batch onwards

3. Examinations:

- i. For the upcoming examinations, though the PGMER-2023 is implemented, the theory question papers will not be carrying MCQs as specified in the General Ordinance.



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- ii. Strict division of the syllabus into paper I, II, III and IV is not possible hence, for the ensuing examinations. The theory question paper pattern will remain as per the old regulations.
- iii. Practical examinations will have to be conducted for 300 marks (including 20 marks for thesis) and 100 marks for viva voce examinations, as per the PGMER -2023. Practical / Clinical examinations marks division shall be made available in consultation with the Board of Studies members or subject experts.
- iv. OSCE / short case shall be included from the ensuing PG examinations as per the PGMER- 2023 regulations
- v. Thesis shall be evaluated for the 20 marks during the practical examinations, for which the student shall submit a copy to the Head of the Department, before the beginning of the practical examination. Five per cent of mark of total marks of Clinical/Practical and Viva Voce marks will be of dissertation/thesis and it will be part of clinical/practical examination marks.
