5. Do not write any answers on your body or dress

**2) HOW STUDENTS SHOULD HANDLE ANSWER BOOKLETS**

**DO'S**

1. To read the instructions in the front page of your answer booklet
2. Carefully fill up part I of the answer booklet provided before the start of exam

**DON'TS**

1. Do not write any word / sentence --starting from page 03 like "names of Gods of your faith" etc.,
2. Do not write your Register no
3. Do not write your name
4. Do not write "P.T.O" at the end of the pages
5. Do not write any irrelevant messages
6. Do not write any word / number / sentence out of context of the answer pertaining to question to be answered
7. Do not tamper the answer booklets
8. Do not write any sign / symbol / letter / word which are likely to be construed as revealing the identify of answer script

Any of the above found in your answer script will amount to "**Malpractice**"
