RGUHS Guidelines for Award of Scholarship to undergraduate students of Health Science Faculties studying in affiliated institutions

1. Objective:

To provide financial assistance to the poor and meritorious students to meet a part of their expenditure while pursuing undergraduate Course Health Sciences in the affiliated colleges of RGUHS.

2. Scope:

The scholarships are awarded on the basis of results of 10+2 examination or equivalent along with certain specified criteria for undergraduate student.

3. Allocation of Scholarship:

Number of scholarship allotted to the students of various faculties are as follows:

Sl.	Faculty		Total no. of Students proposed to be given scholarship
a.	Medical	:	05 students
b.	Dental	:	05 students
c.	Nursing	:	15 students (10 from B.Sc Nursing and 05 from PB B.Sc Nursing)
d.	Pharmacy including Pharma D	:	05 students (02 students from Pharm-D and 03 students from B. Pharm)
e.	Allied health sciences	:	08 students
f.	Physiotherapy	:	05 students
g.	Ayurveda	:	05 students
h.	Homeopathy	:	02 students
i.	Unani	:	02 students
j.	Naturopathy and yoga	:	01 student

4. Amount of Scholarship per annum:

The scholarship amount for each student under various faculties shall be as follows: -

a.	Medical	:	Rs. 30,000/- PA
b.	Dental	:	Rs. 30,000/- PA
c.	Nursing	:	Rs. 20,000/- PA
d.	Pharmacy	:	Rs. 20,000/- PA
e.	Allied health sciences	:	Rs. 20,000/- PA
f.	Physiotherapy	:	Rs. 20,000/- PA
g.	AYUSH	:	Rs. 20,000/- PA

5. Eligibility Criteria:

The student shall be eligible to apply for scholarship by this University, subject to fulfillment of the following criteria:

1. The student should have studied in Karnataka for minimum period of 10 years.
2. The students of MBBS and BDS should have secured 80% AND ABOVE and the students of other Health Science courses should have secured 60% AND ABOVE in 10+2 Or its equivalent examination.
3. The annual income of the parent shall not exceed Rs.6 lakhs per annum.

6. The following categories of students are not eligible under this scheme

- a) Students availing benefit of other scholarship schemes.
- b) Students gaining admission through management/NRI quota.
- c) Students admitted through lateral entry to any UG course.
- d) Students having family income of over Rs.6 lakhs per annum.

7. Duration of scholarship and its renewal

- a) A student will be eligible for the scholarship for the total duration of the course excluding the internship period.
- b) Continuation of scholarship is subject to He / She clearing the exams in the minimum duration specified for the course and has passed in all the subjects in first attempt at each exam. Any failure in this regard will automatically cancel the scholarship awarded.
- c) For continuation of scholarship, every year Students need to submit the renewal application certified as satisfactory by the Head of the Institution is mandatory and it shall be sent directly to the University by the Head of the Institution. The continuation of scholarship will be based on the report of the Head of the Institution.
- d) If a student is unable to appear in the annual examination owing to illness or an account of any unforeseen event, the award of scholarship will be deferred till he/she completes the examination in the next supplementary examination. However, this clause is subject to the student submitting a medical certificate to the effect and other proof to satisfy the head of the institution.
- e) Students changing their college / institution of study as per migration tortes would be allowed to continue the scholarship in the new college and it is the responsibility of the head of the institution of the new college to submit the details of the students who has migrated to the college.

8. Scheme of Evaluation for award of scholarship:

Application of the students who satisfy the above eligibility criteria and the income limit prescribed, shall be evaluated as under :

i. Based on Marks secured in 10+2 / Equivalent examination (in all the subjects):

Students of Medical Dental (MBBS/BDS)	Students of other health science course
More than 95% : 6 marks	More than 90% : 6 marks
Between 90 to 94.99 : 5 marks	Between 80 to 89.99 : 5 marks
Between 85 to 89.99 % : 4 marks	Between 70 to 79.99 : 4 marks
Between 80 to 84.99% : 3 marks	Between 60 to 69.99% : 3 marks

ii. Additional weightage:

1. Student of single parent/ No surviving parents/ Orphans : 2 marks
2. Girl student : 1 mark
3. Son/Daughter of Ex-Service man (Criteria as per KEA Brochure) : 1 mark
4. Differently Abled person (Criteria as per KEA Brochure) : 1 mark
5. Rural student (Criteria as per KEA Brochure) : 2 mark
6. NSS/NCC/ Scouts & Guides (Criteria as per KEA Brochure) : 1 mark
7. Sports (State level awardees) : 1 mark

Maximum marks allotted for a student under the additional weightage category shall not be more than 2 marks.

Based on the summative marks obtained as per the above two evaluation criteria, merit list will be drawn faculty wise and the top ranking students (faculty wise) will be granted scholarship as mentioned in clause 3 (Allocation of Scholarship).

Note:

- (i) In case of two or more students scoring equal marks, scholarship will be awarded to student who has secured more marks in 10+2 or equivalent examination.

- (ii) In case, if aggregate marks in 10+2 or equivalent examination are equal in two or more students, then student who has secured higher marks in 10th or equivalent examination shall be considered for award of scholarship.
- (iii) In case, if aggregate marks in 10th or equivalent examination are equal in two or more students, then student who is older in age shall be considered for award of scholarship.

9. Year of implementation:

Scholarship scheme will be implemented from the academic year 2019-20 onwards.

10. Timeline for submitting the application:

Applications submitted by the eligible students for the RGUHS scholarship to the Heads of the institutions shall be forwarded online by the institution as per the following schedule

Sl.	Faculty	Date of submission
a.	Medical	: 1 st October to 15 th November
b.	Dental	: 1 st October to 15 th November
c.	Nursing	: 15 th January to 15 th March
d.	Pharmacy including Pharma D	: 15 th October to 15 th November
e.	Allied health sciences	: 15 th October to 15 th November
f.	Physiotherapy	: 15 th November to 15 th December
g.	AYUSH	: 15 th November to 15 th December

11. Submission of Application:

The candidates shall fill the details in the hard copy of the prescribed application form and take a print and submit it to the Head of the Institution along with passport photo and prescribed documents. The Head of the Institution shall verify all the documents and countersign the same. The Head of the Institution then shall prepare a merit list of the candidates who have applied for scholarship as per the scheme of evaluation given under clause 8 and then should select the top five students in the merit list and upload their documents online to the University along with scanned copies of enclosures. The URL for submission of online application and guidelines for submitting it to the Head of the Institution will be available to the student at RGUHS official website www.rguhs.ac.in.

12. Preliminary scrutiny of applications :

Preliminary scrutiny of the hard copies of the applications submitted by the students for conformity to the eligibility criteria and other conditions shall be done at the institution level. The Head of the Institution then shall prepare a merit list of the candidates who have applied for scholarship as per the

scheme of evaluation given under clause 8 and then should select the top five students in the merit list and upload their documents online to the University along with scanned copies of enclosures and duly endorsing the certificate on the application form. Hardcopy of the original application (including enclosures) of selected candidates duly signed by the head of the institution shall be forwarded to the University after superscribing the cover as "Application for grant of UG Scholarship" to the following address:



Documents to be uploaded

- (1) Aadhar Enrolment ID
- (2) SSLC Marks Card for Proof of Date of Birth
- (3) Marks Card of 10 + 2 or its equivalent examination issued by the authorized board
- (4) Allotment Letter of KEA
- (5) Caste/Category Certificate/Income Certificate issued by the Competent Authority
- (6) Relevant Certificates for claiming additional weightage (under clause 8)
- (7) Domicile Certificate issued by the Competent Authority
- (8) Photocopy of the front sheet of Bank Pass Book

14. Procedure for Renewal of Scholarship:

Students who has cleared the first and subsequent year examination in first attempt and shall have minimum 75% attendance shall apply for renewal of scholarship online within a month of announcement of results.
