Sub: Inviting applications for continuation of affiliation/ Change of Name & address/ Additional course/Increase intake of Nursing course under RGUHS for the Academic Year 2025-26.

1. Continuation of affiliation:

Applications are invited from all existing affiliated Institutions for issuing continuation of affiliation to all Nursing courses for the academic year 2025-26. Applications/required annexure are to be uploaded through online only. University will not accept any application in paper format.

The Colleges are bound to adopt & implement the Guidelines / Notifications regarding the Curriculum, Syllabus, Minimum Standard Requirements (MSRs) and any other Gazettes/ Notifications notified by Apex body/ GOK / RGUHS as and when they are revised mandatorily.

2. Change of College Name & Change of College Location/ Address.

Applications are also invited from all existing affiliated Institutions for change of name and change of location/ Address for the academic year 2025-26.

- i. If the trust/ Society/ Institution proposes to change the name of the Institute a valid reason to be submitted provided there is no change in the trustees and the name of the trust does not change.
- ii. Change of address within the District/ Taluk/ City/ Village will be considered only on valid reason and fulfilling all infrastructure criteria as per apex bodies/ GOK / RGUHS
- iii. Change of Location (District/Taluk) shall be considered under new proposal as per apex body norms.
- iv. If any college have not admitted candidates continuously for two years or not obtained continuation of affiliation they shall be treated as closed and such colleges shall not be considered for continuation of affiliation. They should apply afresh as per Apex body norms.

Note:

- a) All the applications shall be uploaded as per new proforma prescribed in the online format only within the stipulated time. (The applications submitted in the old proforma will not be considered).
- b) The colleges shall pay full affiliation fees along with the application as per the prescribed dates and to be paid as per Annexure. Partial payment shall not be accepted.
- c) The LIC inspection/ further process of affiliation will be considered only for those colleges who upload all relevant documents through online affiliation Portal forms within the stipulated time. Hard copy / request letters for continuation of affiliation in any other format will not be accepted.
- d) It is mandatory for colleges to submit the online uploaded application for continuation of affiliation as per the above schedule.

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i.	Uploading of Form- 16/ Bank Statement (Minimum of Six consecutive months) of all faculty in the online application portal is compulsory for Change of Name & address/ Additional course/Increase intake of Nursing course.
ii.	The college shall be eligible to apply for Post Graduate course in respective subject specialty only when one undergraduate batch passes out and necessary eligibility criteria specified in the ordinance are fulfilled and also for those institutions which have their own/ Parent Hospital.
iii.	Registered MOU in Rs.500 Stamp paper to be uploaded stating that this hospital will function as parent hospital for 30 years and no other institution will be permitted to be used as parent hospital or affiliated hospital. College has to mandatorily upload / produce the agreement.
iv.	Student - Patient ratio of 1:3 should be maintained by all nursing colleges.
v.	Government Hospitals which have their own nursing colleges cannot be shown as an affiliated hospital to any other nursing colleges
	If applying for additional courses M.Sc. (N) GUIDELINES M.Sc Nursing 1. An institution offering B.Sc (N) Programme wherein one batch has passed out is eligible to establish M.Sc. (N) Programme.

2. **As per the speciality of M.Sc Nursing existing/starting, the clinical facilities to have beds 50-100 in that speciality for clinical postings, besides the criteria of having parent hospital for B.Sc nursing, which is applicable.**
3. Annual admission strength for M.Sc (N) Programme should be on the basis of clinical, physical facilities and teaching faculty.
4. **Student patient ratio-1: 3**
5. Research Guides-Main guide : Nursing faculty / nursing expert in the same clinical speciality holding Ph.D./M.Phil/M.Sc. Nursing with a **minimum of 3 years experience in teaching in the Post Graduate Programme in Nursing**
6. Eligible guide should have university guide ship letter. For M.Sc Nursing & NPCC separate guideship letter is essential.
7. Guide – Students Ratio- 1:5 (inclusive of NPCC and M.Sc Nursing).

NPCC

1. The Government (State/Center/Autonomous) nursing teaching institution offering degree programmes in nursing having **parent tertiary care centre**, with a minimum of 200 beds.
2. Parent Tertiary Care centre should have a minimum of 4 ICUs namely medical ICU, surgical ICU, cardio/thoracic ICU and Emergency care unit with a minimum of 5 beds each and total of 20 beds.
3. The nurse patient ratio should be 1:1 for every shift for ventilated patients c. For the rest of ICU beds the nurse patient ratio should be 1:2 for every shift; Doctor patient ratio can be 1:5
Note : above clinical details to be verified as that of B.Sc nursing parent hospital clinical facility along with parent hospital.
4. Faculty –in Clinical area:
 - Nursing Preceptor: Full time qualified GNM with 6 years of experience in critical care nursing or B.Sc. (Nursing) with 2 years experience in critical care nursing or M.Sc.in Medical Surgical Nursing/Pediatric Nursing/Obstetrics & Gynaecology Nursing Specialty with one year critical care nursing experience.
 - Medical Preceptor: Intensivist
 - Preceptor student ratio: Nursing 1:10,
 - Medical 1:10 (Every student must have a medical and nursing preceptor).
5. Teaching faculty: Professor/Associate Professor – 1 (Teaching experience: 5 years post PG) – M.Sc. in Medical Surgical Nursing/Pediatric Nursing/ Obstetrics & Gynaecology Nursing Specialty (One faculty for every 10 students). Assistant Professor – 1 (Teaching experience: 3 years post M.Sc.).
6. Research guides: Main guide – Nursing faculty (3 years Post PG experience) teaching NP program, Co-guide: Medical preceptor.
7. Guide student ratio: 1:5
8. **Salary:** 1. In-service candidates will get regular salary. 2. Stipend/Salary for the other candidates as per the salary structure of the hospital where the course is conducted.

6.	<p>Application for grant of additional course/increase in intake of affiliation shall be accompanied with the following undertakings as per the provisions stipulated in the "statutes governing the conditions under which colleges may be affiliated to the University" (In Rs.100 Bond paper notarized).</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) That the college is under the management of a registered body (Registered under Societies Registration Act or any other law) with a properly constituted governing council. b) That the total number of members of the governing body will ordinarily be not more than Fifteen (15). c) That the strength and qualification of the teaching staff will be in conformity with the intake fixed by the University and the respective All India Council which is the apex body. d) That the conditions governing the tenure and salary of the teaching staff will be in conformity with the Service Regulations framed by the University from time to time in this behalf and will not be changed to their detriment without the prior approval of the University. e) That the buildings / hospital in which the college is to be located will be lit and ventilated, and that there is in the college buildings accommodations adequate for the number and strength of the classes. f) That due provision will be made for a Library and Library facilities. Any suggestion made by the Local Inquiry Committee must be put into effect at the earliest. g) That the college rules fixing the fees shall be as per the norms fixed by the Government from time to time if any to be paid by the students will not be
