Applications are invited from eligible and interested institutions/ organizations for Fresh course/Additional courses/Increase in intake (UG & PG) for the academic year 2025-26 **From 27th March 2025 to 9th April 2025 with a fine of Rs. 25,000/- per college.**

2 The decision regarding consideration of application by the colleges applied for Allied Health Science & Physiotherapy Colleges for Fresh/Additional courses/Increase in intake will be subject to the approval of the syndicate.

a)	No applications will be entertained after the due date. Only those applications which are complete in all aspects including fee payment will be accepted. If the required fee is not paid / paid partially or if the documents are not submitted/submitted partially, inspection will not be conducted and application will be rejected.	
b)	All Institutions are strictly instructed to make admissions only after receipt of grant of Affiliation notification for the concerned course and for the concerned academic year from the University.	
c)	Latest Guidelines/Minimum Standard Requirement (MSR) for establishment of Fresh Colleges / Courses for Physiotherapy & AHS to be obtained from RGUHS website (BPT Ordinance 2016 & AHS Ordinance 2018, MPT ordinance 2020 & M.Sc. AHS Ordinance). (New guidelines issued if any for Physiotherapy & AHS will be updated in website and same shall be adopted as per the notification issued.)	
d)	Increase in Intake will not be granted to the Institution in which first batch of students have not passed out and also for those institutions which don't have own hospitals.	
e)	The college shall be eligible to apply for Post Graduate course in respected subject specialty only when one under graduate batch passes out and necessary eligibility criteria specified in the ordinance are fulfilled.	
f)	College must submit the following documents if applying for Fresh/ Additional Courses and Increase in intake and Change of address:	
A.	If applying for Fresh Affiliation/ Additional Course:	
	i) Name of the Trust, Year of Registration	Trust shall be minimum 3 years old having minimum 15 lakhs balance per year in the Trust Account and Audit report of last three years to be submitted.
	ii) Trust resolution/ Trust Deed (Enclose copy)	Objective of the trust deed must include developing Educational institutions.
	iii) Land documents of building	All land related documents to be submitted such as Sale deed/Leased deed, RTC, Khata Extract, Tax paid receipt. All building related documents to be submitted such as building is on the same land of the Trust, Building plan approved by competent authority, Building completion/occupancy certificate, up-to-date tax paid receipt /khata certificate, Built-up area details as per RGUHS norms.

	iv) Infrastructure	Institutions must have OWN hospital in the name of Registered Trust / Society. Name of the Owner, Bed Strength, Karnataka State Pollution Control Board Certificate, Karnataka Private Medical Establishment Act Certificate, Inhouse Oxygen generation plant certificate from Government needs to be produced. Statistics of OPD / IPD / Surgeries per day has to be submitted. Hospital should be Medical college attached / ISO/NABL/NABH accredited / recognized. The hospital should have minimum 100 beds for AHS and 100 beds for Physiotherapy as per RGUHS norms.

B)	If applying for Increase in intake:	Following details to be submitted in addition to the above mentioned documents along with details mentioned in 6(d) . (i) One batch of students should have completed the course to apply for enhancement of seats in a particular course. (RGUHS affiliation copy/ copy of Govt. order to be enclosed) (ii) Passing percentage of last 03 years of latest batch to be submitted to apply for enhancement of seats.
C)	If applying for Change of Address:	Following details to be submitted in addition to the above mentioned documents. (i) Affidavit regarding submission of document attested by the notary and change of address in the name of registered trust/society. (ii) Consent of clinical facilities in the new Address (iii) Distance of clinical facilities from the college building (If not in campus) (iv) Trust resolution regarding change of address.
6)	Application for grant of Fresh course/ Additional courses/Increase in intake shall be accompanied with the following undertakings as per the provisions stipulated in the "statutes governing the conditions under

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) That the college is under the management of a registered body (Registered under Societies Registration Act or any other law) with a properly constituted governing council. b) That the total number of members of the governing body will ordinarily be not more than Fifteen (15). c) That the strength and qualification of the teaching staff will be in conformity with the intake fixed by the RGUHS. d) That the buildings / hospital in which the college is to be located will be lit and ventilated, and that there is adequate accommodation for the number and strength of the classes in the college building itself. e) That due provision will be made for a Library and Library facilities. Any suggestion made by the Local Inquiry Committee must be put into effect at the earliest. f) That the college rules fixing the fees shall be as per the norms fixed by the Government from time to time if any to be paid by the students will not be so framed as to involve unfair competition with any existing college or Institute in the same place or neighborhood, or as would be injurious to the interests of education, provided that the fee levied by the Institution will not be less than the standard fees prescribed for the course by the University and not, in any case, more than the standard fees. g) That due provisions will, so far as circumstances permit, be made for the residence of the Principal and Teaching Staff in or near the College or Institute or the place provided for the residence of students. h) That after affiliation being granted all changes affected in the management, teaching staff and all other changes affecting the conditions and terms of affiliation will forthwith be reported to the Syndicate. i) That any scheme of compulsory provident fund etc., laid down by the Government/University will be implemented by the management. j) That the college shall conduct in a disciplined and orderly manner, any University Examination which may be assigned to it as an examination center by the University, and shall abide by the directions and rules issued in this regard by the University. Any failure to comply with the same will make the College liable for such disciplinary action as may be considered essential by the University and including initiation of proceedings for purpose of disaffiliation to such a college. k) Provided that nothing contained in clauses (a) (d) (i) and (j) will be applicable to applications made by Government.
