Dr.M.K.Sudarshan, MBBS (from Karnatak Medical College, Hubli, 1977), MD (from Banaras Hindu University, 1981), is working as Professor & Head of Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Public Health and Centre for Disease Control (RGIPH & CDC), Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore from November, 2014. He retired as Dean/Principal and Professor of Community Medicine from KIMS, Bangalore in October, 2014 after working there for 33 ½ years .He is a member of WHO expert advisory panel (2012-16) and consultations on rabies (2004, 2009 & 2012) & Global Alliance for Vaccines and Immunization (GAVI, 2015) Geneva, Switzerland and Government of India expert committee member (2007 & 2013) on rabies.

He is an honorary fellow of faculty of public health, *Hon.FFPH*, Royal Colleges of Physicians (2010), United Kingdom ; an elected fellow of National Academy of Medical Sciences, *FAMS*, (2008), Delhi and an elected fellow of Indian Public Health Association, *FIPHA*, (2007).
