About Master of Public Health course

The University had launched a postgraduate degree course - Master of Public Health-(Honour) in the academic year 2014-15 and **from the academic year 2019-20**, RGUHS has launched a **2 year Master of Public Health course** to contribute to the pool of public health practitioners, teachers and researchers. The course follows semester system and curriculum is competency based. The assessment will be continuous (formative) with sessional tests, quizzes, presentations, open book tests, case studies, critical reading of journals & term examination.

This course uses diverse range of teaching -learning experiences and activities which include focus on higher cognitive and communication skill development, case studies, field visits, postings to institutions and programmes, and more specifically and specially a period of internship within the course framework.

The classes for the academic batch starts from October onwards every year.

Duration of the course

The course is of two years duration consisting of four semesters with compulsory internship.

Eligibility for admission

The candidate must have a degree i.e., MBBS or BDS or BAMS or BHMS or BUMS or BYNS or BSc (Nursing) or BPT from a university established under law and recognised by respective councils of India (Medical, Dental, AYUSH, and Nursing) where applicable.

or

Equivalent qualification recognised by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences (RGUHS), Karnataka and the respective regulatory bodies/councils.

Criteria for admission

In-service candidates(MBBS): Admission is as per the candidates selected and deputed from the health department as per the procedures (PGET is exempted for In-service candidates).

Other-candidates: Admission is on merit which is based on the performance in the entrance test conducted by the RGUHS.
