Annexure - 1

13. RECOGNITION OF INSTITUTION/COLLEGE AS CENTRES FOR Ph. D STUDIES: The Academic, administrative and infrastructure requirement to be fulfilled by Colleges for getting recognition for offering Ph. D. programmes are as follows:

A candidate shall be permitted to pursue research activities for the degree of Doctor of Philosophy (Ph. D) in any one of the following institutions:

a) Departments run by RGUHS

b) Post Graduate Departments of Colleges/Institutions affiliated to RGUHS :-

1. Recognized as having necessary infrastructure and facilities such as exclusive research laboratories with essential equipment, provision for adequate space per research scholar along with computer facilities and essential software and uninterrupted power and water supply for carrying out research in the subject of study concerned.
2. Provided that the department has at least one qualified Guide in the particular subject.
3. Offering the Postgraduate course for a minimum period of five years in concerned subject.
4. The Post Graduate Department of the said colleges should have been approved by University as a recognized Ph.D. centre.
5. Colleges may also access the required facilities of the neighbouring Institutions/Colleges, or of those Institutions/Colleges/R&D laboratories / Organizations which have the required facilities through an MoU.

c) Any other non-teaching research institution duly recognized by this University for conducting research leading to the award of Ph. D degree on the recommendations of an expert committee appointed by the Syndicate.

Note:

Any non-teaching institutions seeking recognition for Ph. D. programmes:

- 1) Should be a centre of academic excellence and repute or Institute of National Importance.
- 2) Should have been actively functioning and should have been in existence for at least 5 years and should be recognized as a research centre by RGUHS.
- 3) Should be a centre of research activity as evidenced by ongoing research projects funded/ sponsored by reputed agencies like ICMR, AICTE, DST, UGC, CCRAS, CSIR etc. A minimum of two research grants should have been availed in last the 5 years for the concerned department.
- 4) Should have published Five research papers in the peer reviewed scientific journals or indexed journals in the last 5 years in the subject specialty for which the PhD is sought.
- 5) Should have specifically equipped research labs with the requisite infrastructure and facilities for the proposed Ph. D programme.
- 6) The Department which proposes to start the Ph. D programme in the institution should have at least three staff members with required PG qualification in the concerned specialty and a total of 10 years Post Graduate teaching or research experience.

13.1) RECOGNITION OF INSTITUTION/COLLEGE AS CENTRES FOR Ph. D STUDIES IN NURSING FACULTY.;

- Having own single unitary parent hospital with minimum of 300 beds accredited by NABH/JCI/GOVT with 70% occupancy in the concerned specialty in the past three years . The affiliated hospital beds will not be considered.
- Having own college building as per norms of the apex body and university.
- Exclusive research laboratories with state of the art equipment, provision for adequate space per research scholar along with essential facilities and software, with uninterrupted power and water supply for carrying out research in the subject of study concerned.
- Every College of Nursing having M.Sc. (Nursing) approved by the University to start Ph.D. in nursing shall have minimum of two Ph.D. degree holders who are regular faculty in nursing out of which one of them should be an RGUHS approved Ph.D. Guide .
- Offering the Postgraduate course for a minimum period of five years in concerned subject.
- Colleges may also access the required facilities of the neighboring Institutions/Colleges, or of those Institutions/Colleges/R&D laboratories / Organizations which have the required facilities through an MoU, provided such institute should not have Ph.D. in the same subject in same faculty.

13.2) RECOGNITION OF INSTITUTION/COLLEGE AS CENTRES FOR Ph. D. STUDIES IN DENTAL FACULTY.;

- In addition to the apex body requirement for PG courses one extra dental chair and unit per Ph.D. scholar is required.

13.3) RECOGNITION OF INSTITUTION/COLLEGE AS CENTRES FOR Ph. D. STUDIES IN AYUSH FACULTY.;

- As per the Apex body norms ,minimum standard of education and minimum standard of regulation, an institution must have own land/society registration according to the Urban and Sub urban areas.
- For the Clinical Speciality PG Departments , bed strength should be maintained as per the MSR(Minimum standard of regulation) as mentioned in Apex body guidelines.
- A quality control unit should be maintained (QC lab)
- Research and Development department should be well established.
- Departmental Research Committee (DRC), Institutional Research Committee (IRC) and Institutional Ethical committee (IEC) must be functional.
- Institution/ Department must have association with experimental lab/animal house (should have MoU)
- Department of Kriya Shareera and Roga Nidana must have developed teaching and clinical laboratory facilities.
- Department of Samhita Siddhanta must have developed transcription library, Digital Library for literary research.
- Department of Dravya Guna, AgadaTantra and Rasa shastra must have collaboration with Pharmacology, Phamacognosy and Pharmaceutics units.

13.4) RECOGNITION OF INSTITUTION/COLLEGE AS CENTRES FOR Ph. D. STUDIES IN ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCES.:

- For an institute to be recognized as a centre for Ph.D. for Allied health sciences faculty, must be managed and controlled by the Trust, the owner of the Hospital/Lab is a member of the Trust.
- Hospital/Clinical Diagnostic facility must be NABL/NABH accredited or Government hospital /Lab.
- All these institutes must satisfy the Minimum standard requirements laid down by RGUHS/Apex body of the concerned specialization.

Fee Structure:

The fee structure could be similar as per the existing fee structure for the Ph. D. programme in the teaching institutions. (Vide University notification No.ACA/ORD-23/97-98 (Part II) dated 07.07.2005. Institutions/Colleges desirous of seeking recognition of their Departments by the University as Ph.D. study centres may contact the R&D section of the University for obtaining the application form, and the prescribed fee shall be paid along with the application . All Ph.D. study centres both teaching and non-teaching institutions shall seek renewal of recognition every three years on payment of prescribed fees.

14. DEPOSITORY WITH LIBRARY

- 14.1 Following the successful completion of the evaluation process and before the announcement of the award of the Ph.D. degree(s), the Institution concerned shall submit an electronic copy of Ph.D. thesis to the RGUHS Library for hosting the same in RGUHS website so as to make it accessible to all Institutions / Colleges.
- 14.2 Prior to actual award of the degree, the degree awarding Institution shall issue a provision Certificate to the effect that the Degree has been awarded in accordance with the provisions of these UGC Regulations, 2016.
